

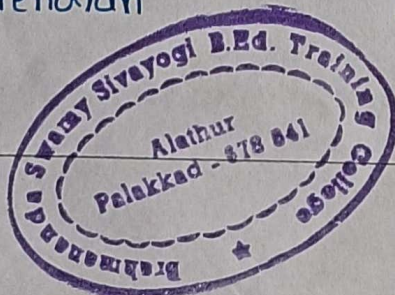



- (10.) Mobile learning.

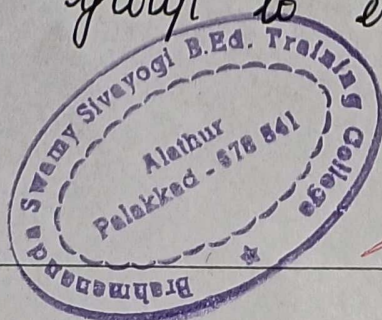
