### WORLD WILDLIFE DAY







The celebration concluded with the National Anthem, marking the end of an inspiring and thought-provoking literary gathering.




















### WORLD WATER DAY

The World Water Day 2025 celebration was a resounding success, inspiring students, educators, and community members to take collective action for the conservation of Bharathapuzha and other vital water resources.














### **EID - CELEBRATION**
