The speech about the importance of the International Women's Day made by Aparna.U. In this occasion, as a part of "Harit ghar" Paryavaran Sanrakshan is an all





Report on Consumer rights day celebration


World Consumer Rights Day is marked on 15 March of every year. The day is observed for creating awareness about the rights of all consumers against fraud, discrimination, and other such practices.



At the end of the session Rohini ps from Commerce option has delivered vote of thanks. The programme ended by National anthem.








HOLI DAY CELEBRATION




