## **OATH TAKING CEREMONY**



## **NATIONAL CANCER AWARENESS DAY**

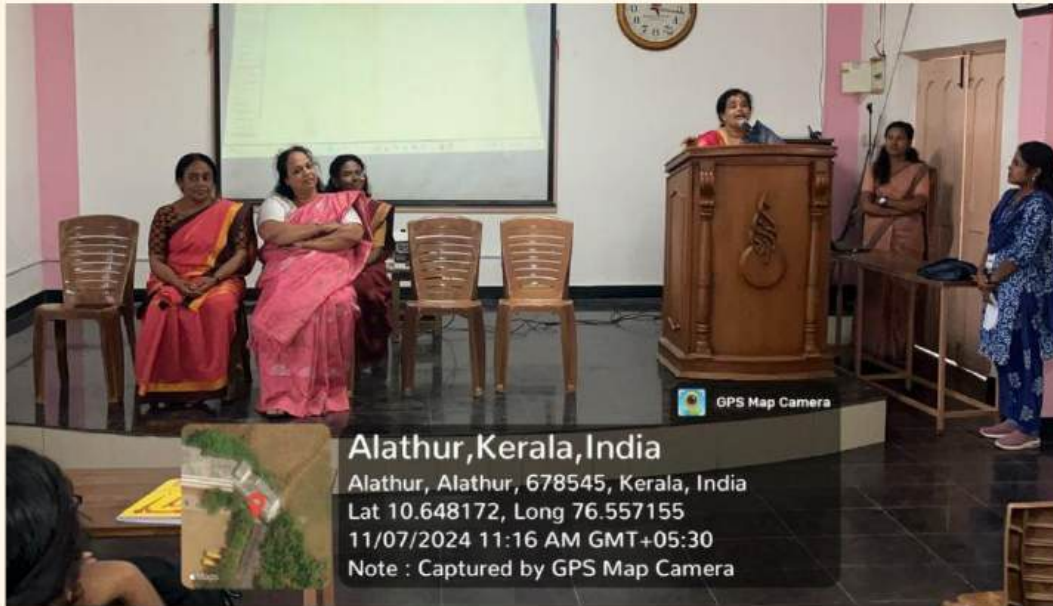

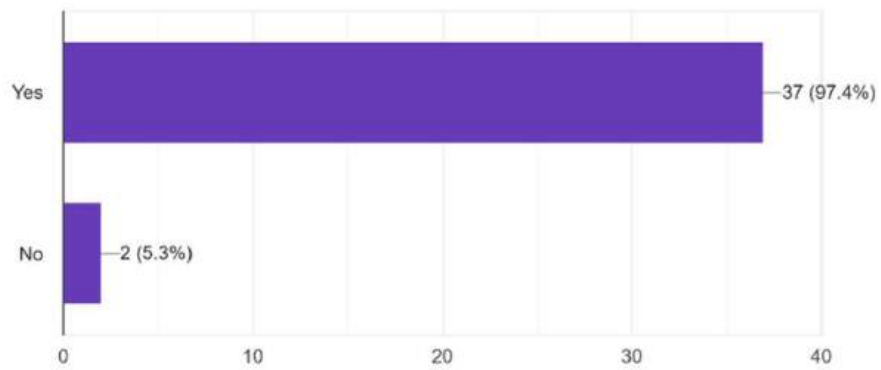

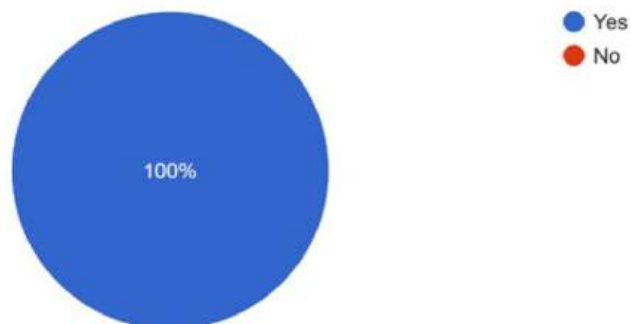
1. Do you know that National Cancer Awareness Day is observed in India?

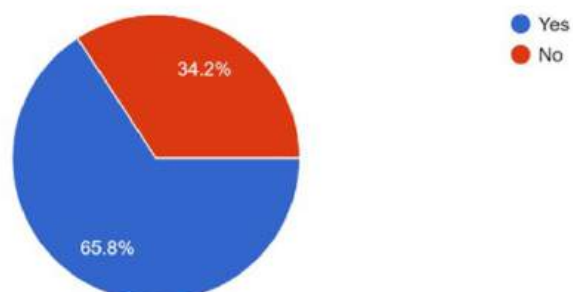

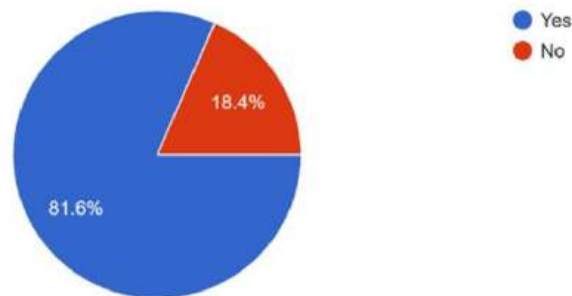
13. Are you aware of the most common types of cancer in India?

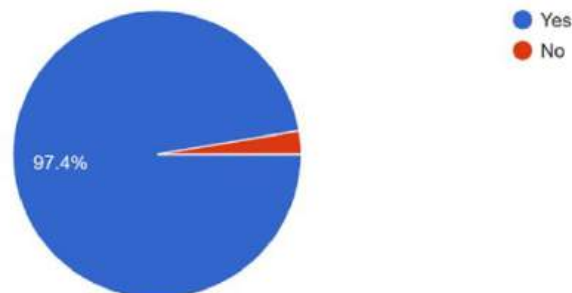
14. Do you think stigma and fear surrounding cancer can be reduced through awareness programs?

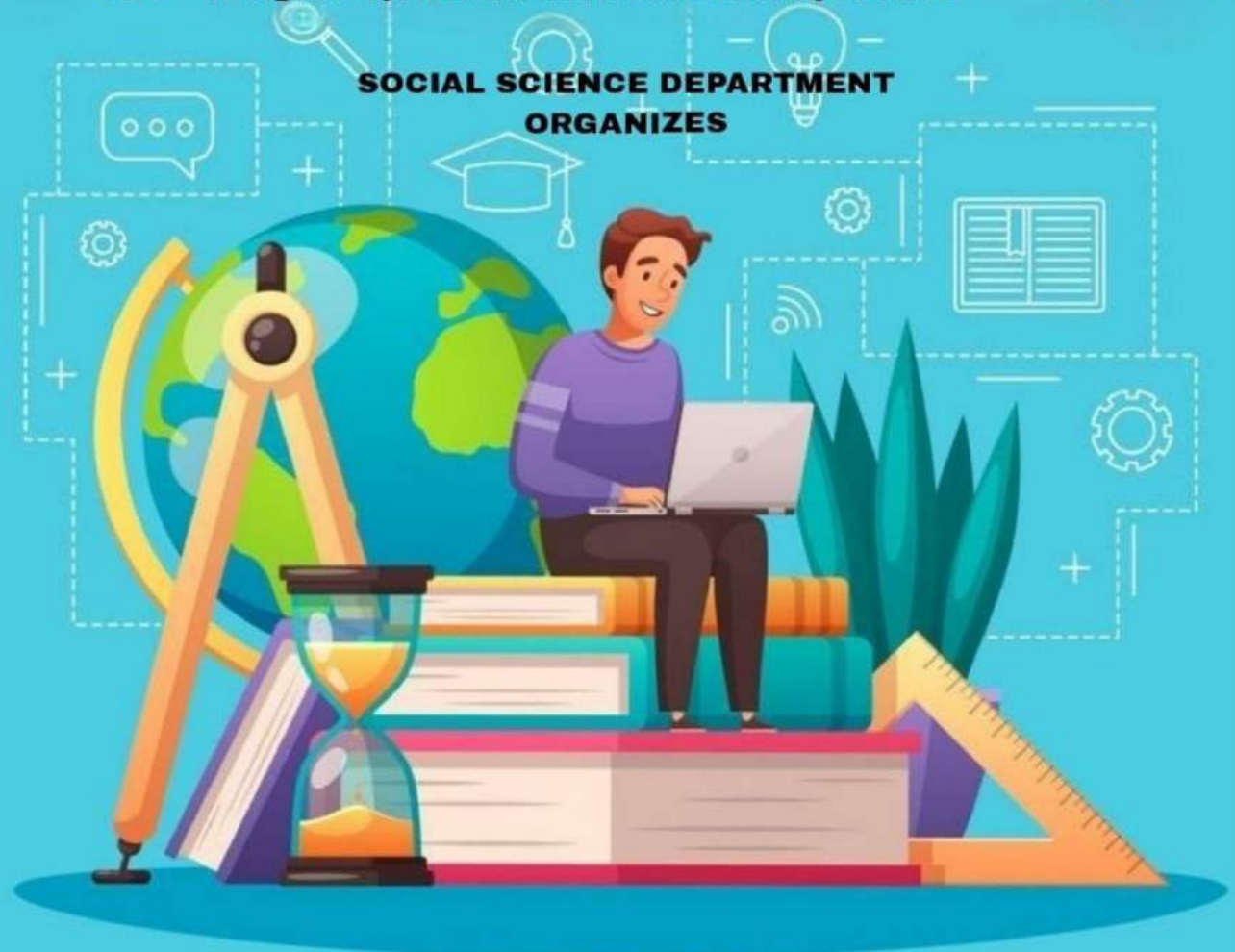

## **NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY**

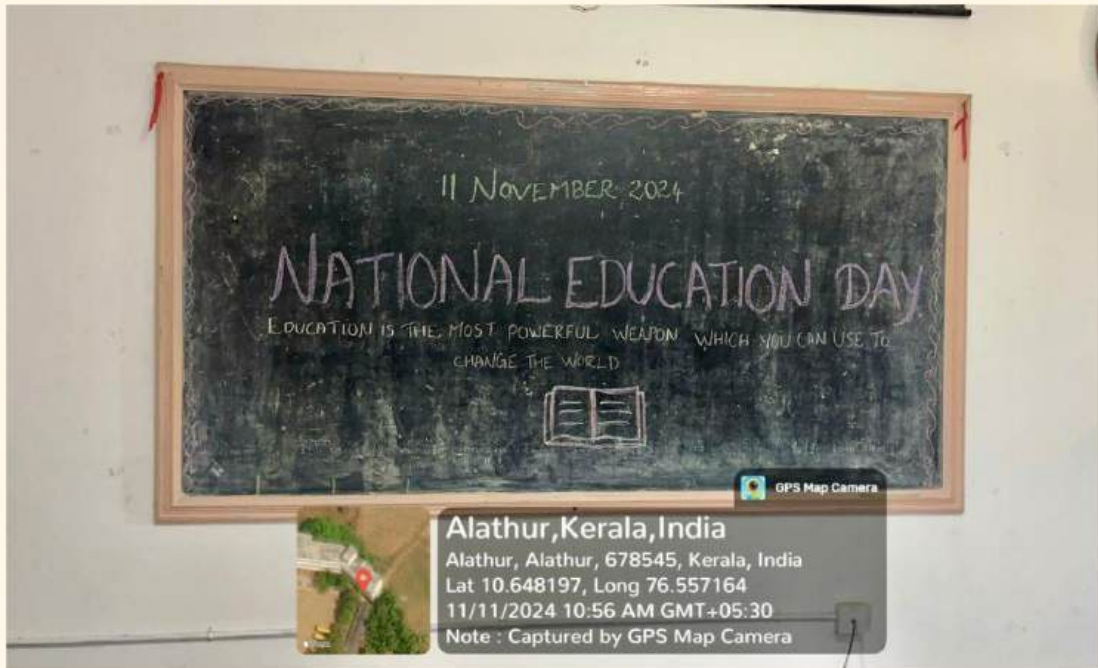

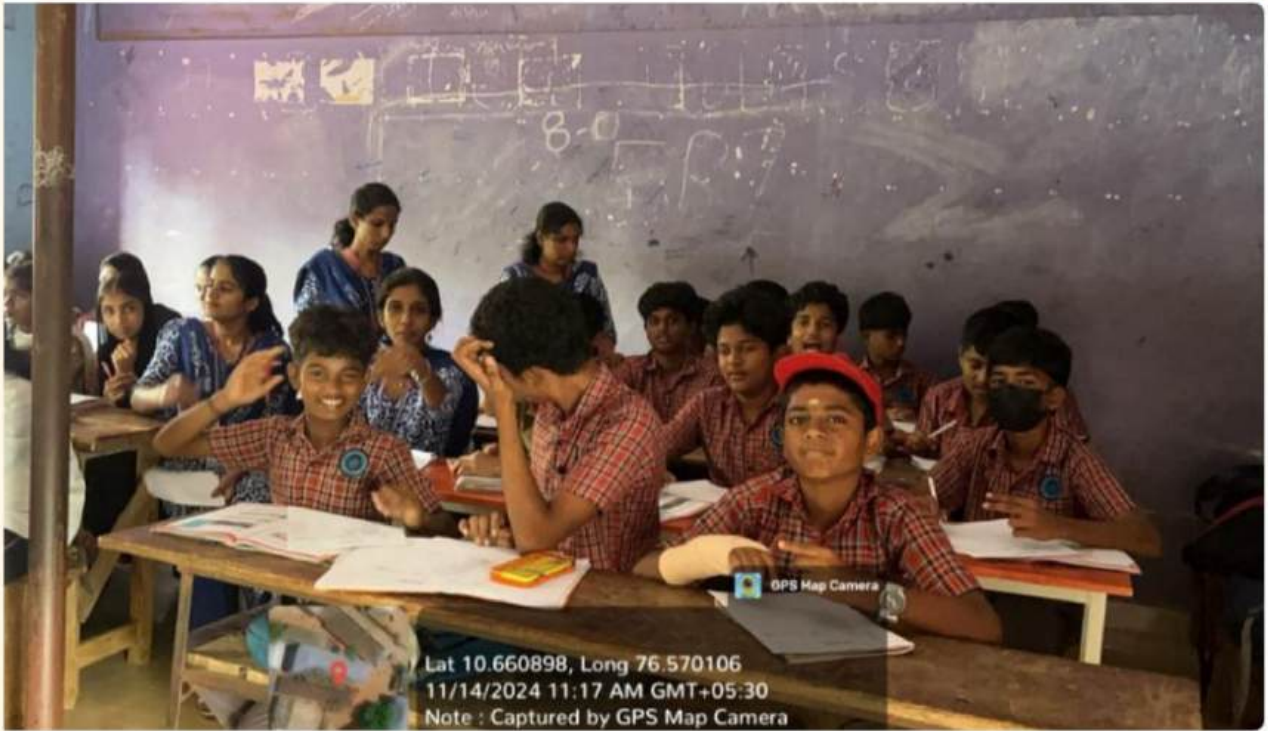
## **CHILDREN' DAY**


The program commenced with a warm welcome to the gathering, which included students, faculty members, and the esteemed presence of our Principal, Balambika Ma'am.
